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After the first repeat, prior grades count toward the student's GPA.

ACADEMIC PROBATION

Placement on Probation: Students will be placed on academic probation at the end of any semester in which their grade point average (GPA) is below 2.0. Students on probation have one semester in which to achieve a non-cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. (Non-cumulative GPA is defined as a single-semester GPA.) If they do so in their subsequent semester, they are removed from academic probation. Failure to do so results in dismissal from the university.

Removal of Probation and Dismissal: Probation will be removed at the end of any semester in which the student attains a cumulative GPA of 2.0. (Cumulative GPA is defined as the total grade point average for all semesters since entering the university.) A student will be dismissed if he or she fails to remove his/her probation by the end of the third semester on probation. Action involving academic probation and dismissal are entered on the student's permanent record.

Reinstatement: Students who left PMU not in good standing and have been out of the university for no more than two semesters may submit a written request for reinstatement to the Office of the Registrar. The request should outline activities since leaving PMU that contribute to the student's academic development. Courses taken at another institution during this interim period are not transferable.

Students who have been out of the university for more than two semesters must submit a new application for admission to the Office of Admissions. Dismissed students may also be considered for reinstatement.
