
Number of employees in tourism activities exceeds 966 thousand during Q4 of 2024

The total number of employees in tourism activities reached 966,531 during Q4 of 2024, reflecting an increase of 4% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, which was 929,404. The number of Saudi employees reached 242,073, with a participation rate of 25%. Meanwhile, the number of non-Saudi employees reached 724,458, representing a participation rate of 75% of the total employees in tourism activities (Figure 1). On the other hand, the number of male employees in tourism activities reached 837,972, with a participation rate of 86.7%, while the number of female employees in tourism activities reached 128,559, with a participation rate of 13.3% of the total employees in tourism activities during Q4 of 2024.

Contribution of employees in tourism activities

The percentage of employees in tourism activities reached 5.5% of the total employees in the economy during Q4 of 2024, marking a decrease of 0.3 percentage points compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, which was 5.8%. The percentage of employees in tourism activities reached 8.2% of the total employees in the private sector, marking a decrease of 0.8 percentage points compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, which was 9% (Figure2).

Room occupancy rate in tourist hospitality facilities

The hotel room occupancy rate was approximately 56% during Q4 of 2024, marking a decrease of 4.3 percentage points compared to Q4 of 2023, which was 60.2% due to the high number of licensed hotels (see Table 1). On the other hand, the room occupancy rate in serviced apartments and other hospitality facilities was 55.9% during Q4 of 2024, reflecting an increase of 0.5 percentage points compared to the rate in the corresponding quarter of 2023, which was 55.4% (Figure3). Moreover, number of licensed tourism hospitality facilities increased by the end of the fourth quarter of 2024, reaching 4,425 hospitality facilities, including 2,163 hotels, 2,262 serviced apartments, and other hospitality facilities (see Table 1).

Figure 3. Room occupancy rate by facility type (%), (2023-2024)




Average daily room rate in tourist hospitality facilities

The average daily room rate in hotels was approximately SAR 440 during Q4 of 2024, reflecting an increase of 2.1% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, which was SAR 449 due to the high number of licensed hotels (see Table 1). On the other hand, the average daily room rate in serviced apartments and other hospitality facilities was approximately SAR 220 during the same quarter, reflecting an increase of 25.1% compared to Q4 of 2023, which was SAR 176 (Figure4).

Average length of stay for guests in tourist hospitality facilities

The average length of stay for guests in hotels was approximately 3.6 nights during Q4 of 2024, which is the same average as in the corresponding quarter of 2023. On the other hand, the average length of stay for guests in serviced apartments and other hospitality facilities was approximately 2.1 nights during the same quarter, reflecting a decrease of 12.1% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, which was 2.4 nights (Figure 5).

Figure 5. Average length of stay by facility type (nights), (2023-2024)


